Selection is based on the following criteria:

- 1) Achievement or sustained performance showing the commitment of the member or its employees to enhancing the quality of life in its community through activities which:
 - a. Address community need or improve the community's social, cultural, educational, or economic environment; and
 - b. Provide an opportunity for employee involvement.
- 2) And the achievement or sustained performance of the nominated member:
 - a. Served to enhance the prestige of public power and the Association in the state generally
 - b. Improved service to customer/owners, and
 - c. Represented an earnest, coordinated effort on the part of the system.
